Standardised Price List

Funeral directors are obligated by law to provide a Standardised Price List containing a predetermined set of products and services. This list serves as a guide to assist you in making informed decisions and to enable you to compare prices among different funeral directors, as costs may vary.

Unattended funeral - Direct Cremation - £975

This type of funeral allows family and friends to hold a ceremony, event, or service to honor the deceased, but they do not attend the burial or cremation.

Additional products and services:

Urgent collection (location that doesn't have a mortuary) - £325

Delivery of ashes within 21 days - £0

Additional mileage (price per mile) - £1.20 per mile will apply after the first 20 miles.

¹ In England, Wales, and Northern Ireland, you are typically required to pay doctors' fees, which cover the cost of a doctor signing the Medical Certificates for Cremation. (This is usually £82)

² Additionally, there is usually a fee associated with removing any medical devices, prostheses, or objects that cannot be safely cremated with the deceased, such as pacemakers, metal implants, metal plates, and battery-operated devices. You can inform your funeral coordinator if you wish to have any of these items returned to you.
